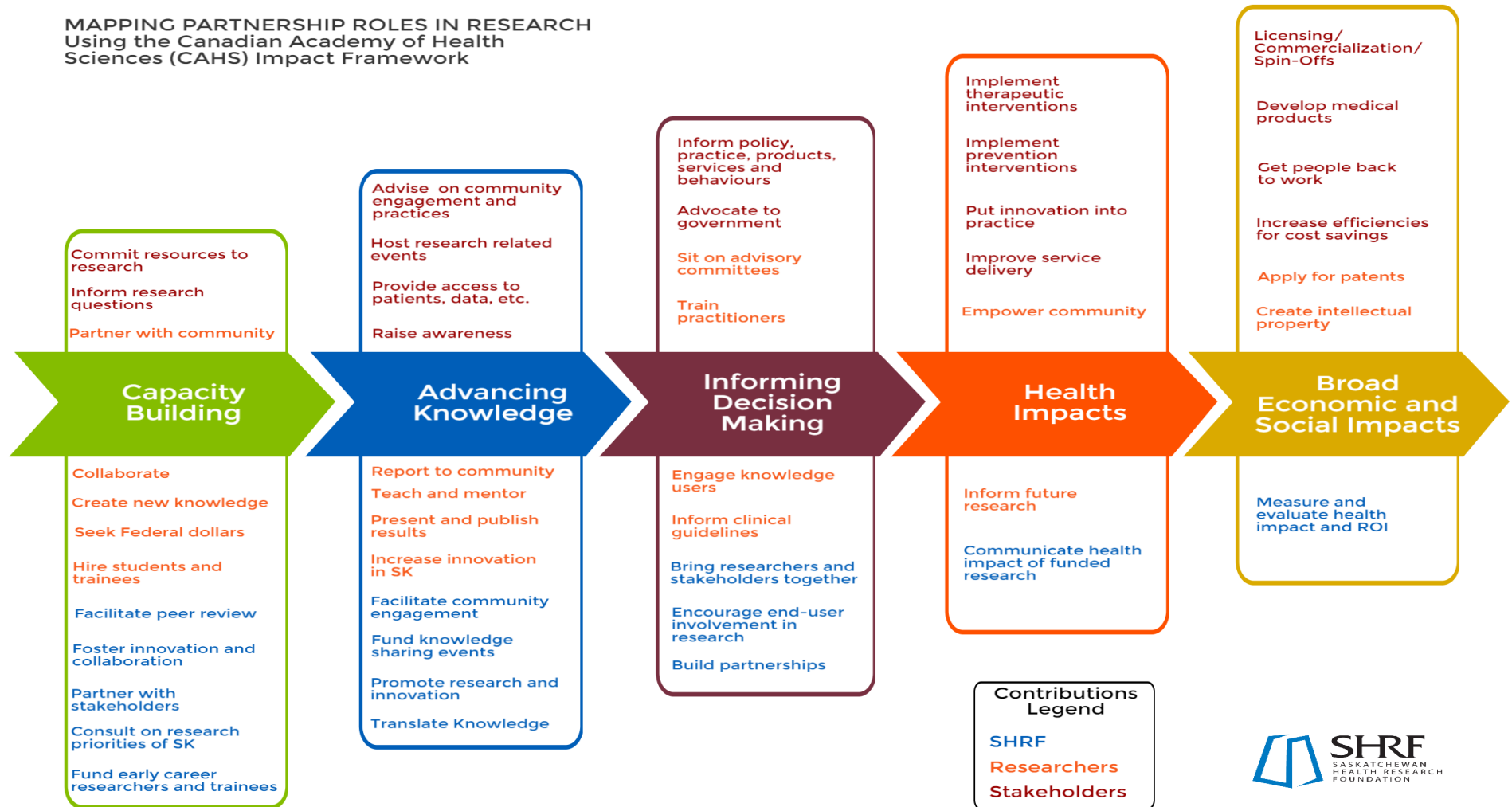


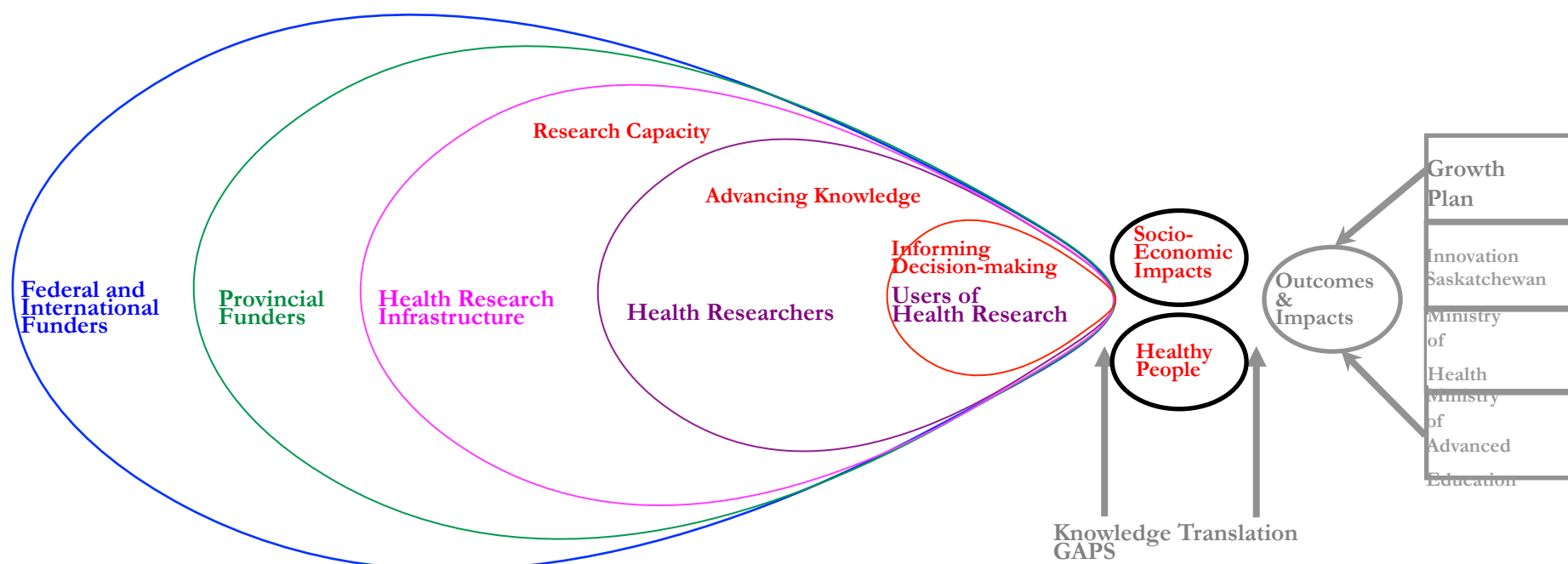

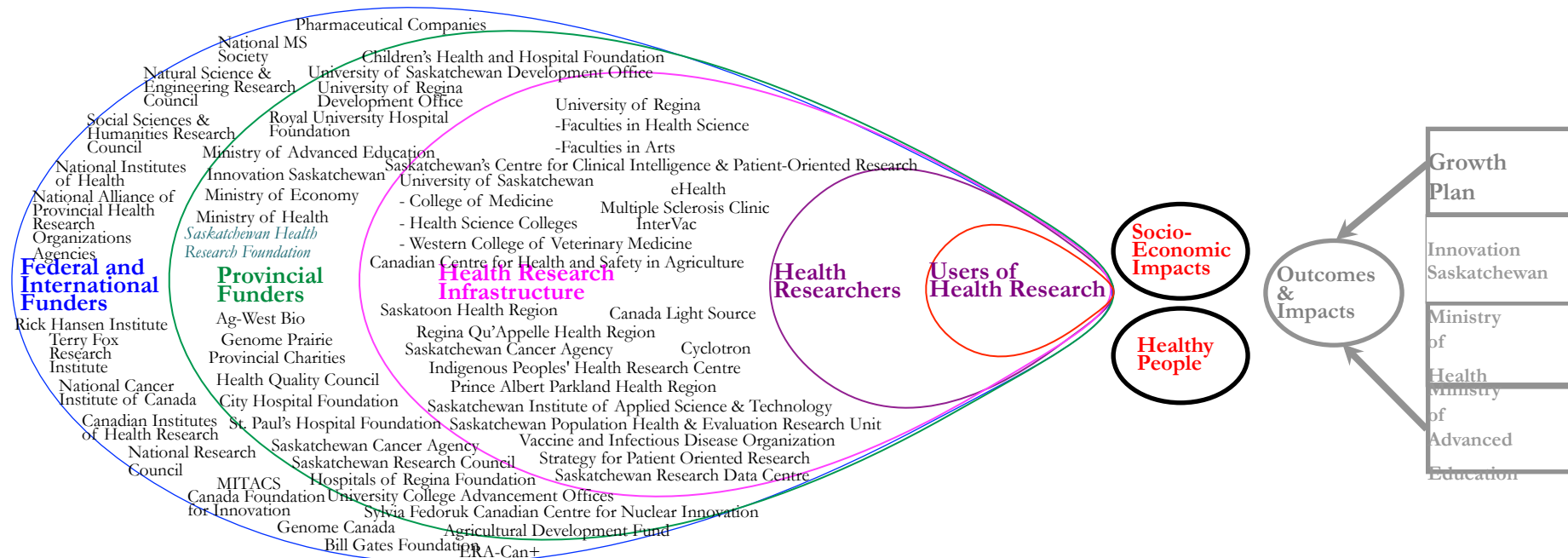

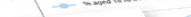

Scientific output of Saskatchewan in Health Sciences – Collaborations between Universities and other sectors

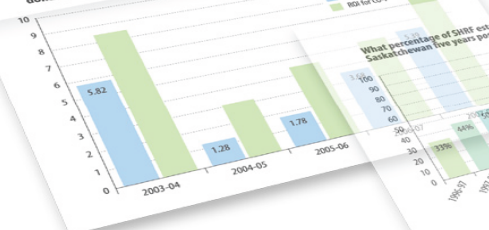


Prevalence of adult obesity Saskatchewan, calendar-year
