

**Dr. Jane Whynot,

Dr. Jane Whynot is currently a partner at Goss Gilroy Inc. (GGI) and leads their social-cultural line of business. Dr. Whynot has provided performance measurement and evaluation expertise through consulting engagements to both the federal government and the non-profit sector for almost 25 years. She holds a PhD from the Institute of Feminist and Gender Studies at the University of Ottawa; her area of research regards the integration of Gender-based Analysis Plus (GBA+) in the Canadian federal government evaluation system.
